Recipient must:

- Be a licensed mental health professional in good standing
- Agree to attend all Play Therapy trainings <u>in-person</u>
- Agree to complete all homework assignments
- Agree to complete the Impact Research pre-test and post-test
- Submit a copy of their resume for review
- Submit a one-page letter of interest specifying how the applicant will use Play Therapy specifically to treat BIPOC populations
